

## plug and work expanding in Switzerland

- **Offices from 15 square metres, coworking, virtual office**
- **Directly at Zurich Airport**

**ZURICH** – Starting from 15 September, flexible office space is to be opened directly at Zurich Airport with cutting-edge workspace for companies requiring 1 to 15 workstations. The plug and work group will initially occupy 1,200 square metres and then from February onwards 2,400 square metres. “We are delighted to continue our expansion in the international metropolis of Zurich,” says Managing Partner Holger Starp. The location in Kloten represents another milestone in the company’s history, he adds.

The provider of fully equipped, high-quality office space will move in to the top storey of the hotel/office complex built in 2008, located directly opposite the arrival and departure areas. The building, which is also home to the Radisson Blu, has a direct connection to the terminal. There is also direct access to the airport shopping centre. “It is an outstanding building in every respect at a unique location,” comments Kerstin Pannek, Expansion Manager at the plug and work group. According to Pannek, fast access to the city centre played an equally important role in the decision on the location as the excellent connections to all modes of transport. The airport is Switzerland’s best-connected location, she adds.

The company also announced that customers will be provided with an extensive range of services, such as secretarial tasks, as well as the entire technical infrastructure. Companies just have to plug in a laptop and they can start work immediately. The office spaces with variable contract terms can be made smaller or larger as required. For companies of any size and sector that wish to have 1 to 15 employees based on site, plug and work offers a flexible alternative to conventional rental space. Starp concludes by saying: “Owing to the high demand that is already

foreseeable now, we will soon be opening further locations in Switzerland!”

The plug and work group is one of the leading providers of modern workspace in Europe. It was established in 1998 by Holger Starp.
